

Rules of the Race



- ☞ Cars raced in previous years are not eligible. All participating cars must be built specifically for this race.
- ☞ Clubbers must use the axles, wheels and wood supplies in the kit. Additional features (windshields, weights, decals, wood fenders, etc.) can be added.
- ☞ All cars must be certified to meet size and weight specifications before the race. The maximum allowable weight is 5 ounces. The maximum length is 7 inches. The maximum width is $2 \frac{3}{4}$ inches. The maximum height is 4.5 inches. Cars that exceed specifications will be disqualified.
- ☞ In order to fit on the track, the chassis should not be lower than $\frac{3}{8}$ of an inch from the ground. The distance between the right and left wheels should be at least $1 \frac{3}{4}$.
- ☞ The car number should appear somewhere on the car, but it can be written on the bottom.
- ☞ After a car is certified, it will remain in the possession of the race commissioner until after the race. Clubbers will not have access to cars once they are certified.
- ☞ If a car jumps the track during the race, the race will begin again. If a car jumps the track three times, it is eliminated and the race will begin again with the remaining cars.
- ☞ Clubbers may not race their cars against each other before or after the race.
